Are photovoltaic panels a 'large equipment'?

Photovoltaic (PV) panels have been in the scope of Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) since August 2012 and are classified as category 4: "large equipment". Member States are supposed to ensure that collection targets for this category¹ are achieved on a yearly basis.

How do photovoltaic solar panels work?

Photovoltaic solar panels (PV), are composed of silicon semiconductors, which capture energy from the sun's rays. The process is named the photovoltaic effect.
