Are South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands mountainous?

South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands are a collection of islands in the South Atlantic Ocean. Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow.

What is the ccTLD for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The Internet country code top-level domain (ccTLD) for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is .gs. The parts of the islands that are not permanently covered in snow or ice are part of the Scotia Sea Islands tundra ecoregion.

How big is South Georgia Island?

South Georgia Island lies at 54°15'S 36°45'W and has an area of 3,528 square kilometres (1,362 sq mi). It is mountainous and largely barren. Eleven peaks rise to over 2,000 metres (6,600 ft) high, their slopes furrowed with deep gorges filled with glaciers; the largest is Fortuna Glacier.

Are the South Georgia Islands mountainous?

Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow. The South Georgia Group lies about 1,390 kilometres (860 mi; 750 nmi) east-southeast of the Falkland Islands, at 54°S; 36°W.

South Georgia is situated 800 miles SE of the Falkland Islands. The main island of South Georgia is approximately 170 km long and between 2 and 40 km wide and occupies an area of 3,755 km², more than half of which is permanently ice covered. The coast is rich in wildlife and home to huge colonies of penguins, seals and albatross.

The Antarctic Treaty of 1962 resulted in a separation of the British Antarctic Territory from the UK Dependencies. South Georgia then received its first stamps. In 1985 the Falkland Islands Dependencies ceased to exist and South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands came into existence as a UK overseas territory.

The former Falkland Islands dependency of South Georgia became a separate British territory in 1985, with the (uninhabited) South Sandwich Islands attached.. Its first issue was the 1986 Elizabeth II 60th Birthday set. This and most following issues were inscribed South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands. Some later issues are inscribed in all caps/capital letters.

1 South Georgia Island is the only inhabited island, with the summer-only settlement of Grytviken, and the only one regularly visited by cruise ships. Minor islands are ranged along its north coast - those visited by cruises are Willis, Bird, Albatross and Prion, and Cooper. The south coast is exposed to raging winds and waves and is seldom visited - Annenkov is the only large island ...

The island of South Georgia is unusual among oceanic islands for having pre-Cretaceous sedimentary rocks underlying much of the island and a significant portion of felsic igneous rocks. Two-thirds of the island consists of intensely folded flysch, capped with Aptian age fossils, tuff and greywacke in the Cumberland Bay Series.

South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands is at the northern limit of the krill distribution. Krill at South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands are not self-sustaining but dependent on the northerly movement of krill in the currents of the Southern Ocean from their spawning grounds under the ice in the Antarctic Peninsula and Weddell Sea.

A list of 49 approved visitor sites is included as an annex in the Visiting South Georgia. Some approved sites are only suitable for Zodiac cruising and cruise ships carrying in excess of 200 passengers are only permitted to land passengers at certain sites.

South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands are only accessible by sea. There is no visitor accommodation ashore, therefore most people visit by cruise ship or yacht. All visits require a visit permit. Visit permit applications for both commercial and private vessels are submitted by the vessel owners or operators.

HPAI has now been confirmed from 23 sites across South Georgia.
