

What is the main energy source in Bhutan?

On-grid hydropower is the country's main energy source. Bhutan operates four major hydroelectric facilities, several small and mini hydroelectric generators, and has a handful of further sites in development. Many of the small and mini hydropower plants in Bhutan serve remote villages that remain disconnected from the power grid.

How much power does Bhutan have?

Bhutan's installed power generation capacity is approximately 1.6 gigawatts (GW). Over 99 percent of the country's installed capacity comes from hydropower plants, accounting for 1,614 megawatts (MW) of the country's total capacity of 1,623 MW in 2018. More than 99.97 percent of households have access to electricity.

What is Bhutan doing to diversify its energy mix?

The development is part of Bhutan's plans to diversify its energy mix beyond traditional hydropower to include solar and geothermal sources. The strategy involves diversifying project structuring and financing through strategic partnerships. This collaboration is supported by the governments of Bhutan and India.

How many MW does Bhutan generate?

"Bhutan currently generates only 2,444 MW, about 7.5 percent of its potential. However, this agreement to develop 5,000 MW brings us closer to His Majesty's vision of generating 20,000 MW," he said.

Hydropower remains a cornerstone of Bhutan's economy, and capitalising on this resource will not only meet the country's growing energy demands but also create green jobs and contribute to infrastructure development.

How much hydropower does Bhutan have?

Bhutan's installed hydropower capacity stands at 1,615 megawatts as of 2016, out of an estimated hydropower potential of 30,000 megawatts (23,760 megawatts of which is considered technologically and economically feasible). Hydropower generation drops significantly in the winter due to mountain streams freezing over.
