

How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

How does a solar panel installation work?

The installer will have to lift some of the roof tiles to fix the anchors to the rafters in the loft. This will give the solar panel mounts a stable foundation, and will make sure they don't get damaged in stormy weather. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.

How do you install solar panels on a roof?

**Rail and Panel Installation** The cheapest and most practical way to install solar panels is with a combination of rails and brackets. A secure hook is fastened to the rafters underneath your roof tiles and the rails are attached to these exposed hooks across the length of the solar array.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.
