What items should not be stored in a storage unit?

Can you put items in a storage unit?

This includes general items you can't put in a storage unit either for safety reasons or for legal reasons.

Should you store illegal items in a storage unit?

Can you keep toxic items in a storage unit?

If an item is toxic, flammable, or combustible, then you're not going to be able to keep it in a storage unit. This includes: Even some household cleaners may fall on this list if they're particularly toxic or dangerous.

Should you put fragile items in a storage unit?

Just as you wouldn't send a fragile item through the mail without proper packaging, you shouldn't put items in a storage unit without the right packing materials. The right materials can protect your belongings from dust, moisture, and damage. Use sturdy, high-quality boxes that can withstand stacking.
