How much electricity can be derived from a photovoltaic system, and under what conditions, depends strictly on the solar panel. For this reason, research is directed mainly toward three goals: improving conversion efficiency (i.e., more electric watts at the same irradiance), increasing the usable angle from which to receive the sun's rays, and increasing panel durability.

Solar potential of New Zealand Solar panels on a home in Auckland. Solar power in New Zealand is increasing in capacity, in part due to price supports created through the emissions trading scheme. As of the end of April 2024, New Zealand has 420 MW of grid-connected photovoltaic (PV) solar power installed, of which 146 MW (35%) was installed in the last 12 months. [1]

Solar panels sold by reputable companies in New Zealand usually have a performance warranty range between 25 and 30 years. The panel's product warranty can range between 10 years and 25 years. This tells us we can expect solar panels to last at least 25 years which is a factor when figuring out the payback on investing in solar.

Most solar energy incident (>70%) upon commercial photovoltaic panels is dissipated as heat, increasing their operating temperature, and leading to significant deterioration in electrical performance.

On average, the total cost of installing a solar panel is around \$9000, with the average cost of a single solar panel (270W- 350W) is around \$300. However, this figure can vary easily depending on your energy consumption level. At large, energy consumption can be classified into three categories.

The TechCollect Reports identify PV panels as problematic for product stewardship, as there are currently no dedicated PV recycling service providers in New Zealand.
