Can breast milk be stored in a sterilised container?

You can store breast milk in a sterilised container or in special breast milk storage bags: Breast milk that's been cooled in the fridge can be carried in a cool bag with ice packs for up to 24 hours. Storing breast milk in small quantities will help avoid waste. If you're freezing it, make sure you label and date it first.

How should breast milk be stored?

Always use a sterile container with a lid, not the collection jug, to store breast milk. Take care with plastic bags as they can puncture easily. Use a different storage container each time you collect milk. If necessary, newly collected milk may be cooled and added to previously stored milk on the same day only.

How long can breast milk be stored in a cooler?

Breast milk can be safely transported in insulated coolers with frozen ice packs for up to 24 hours, after which it should be used immediately, stored in a refrigerator, or frozen. [12] The frozen ice packs must be in constant contact with the milk containers, and the cooler should not be opened unless absolutely necessary.

Can breast milk be stored in ice packs?

Protect your milk from direct contact with the ice packs or it may freeze - try wrapping the ice packs in kitchen towel. The bag can also be used to carry milk. The lower the storage temperature, the longer expressed breast milk can be stored.

When thinking about where to store milk, temperature is the key factor. When milk gets exposed to air it will lose its freshness quicker and go off much faster, so it's important to keep it sealed and store it in a chilled
