Who is developing a collie battery in Western Australia?

UGL is developing and constructing Stage 1 of the Collie Battery in Western Australia for client Neoen. This battery energy storage system (BESS) has a capacity of 219MW/877MWh and includes associated energy infrastructure, construction of an access track to the site.

What is a 'collie Bess' battery?

"When complete, this battery will support reliability and more renewable energy on WA's main electricity grid." The Collie BESS is Synergy's third big battery, with work already completed on the first-stage 100MW, two-hour battery at Kwinana and started on the second stage of that facility, which will be sized at 200 MW and four hours (800 MWh).

What is the Collie battery energy storage system (cbess) project?

In line with the WA State Government's decarbonisation strategy to be delivered by 2030, our Collie Battery Energy Storage System (CBESS) Project forms part of Synergy's decarbonisation strategy. Coal-fired power generation is being replaced with renewable energy generation infrastructure and energy storage solutions.

What is a collie Bess & how will it benefit synergy?

The Collie BESS will join Synergy's existing battery systems in Kwinana, soaking up excess solar and wind energy during the day to provide system stability and support continued uptake of renewables in the SWIS (South West Interconnected System).

What does the Collie Bess mean for Western Australia?

Western Australia Premier, Roger Cook, said that the Collie BESS will be one of the biggest in Australia, and means that the State Government can deliver clean, affordable and reliable energy for Western Australia for decades to come.

Is synergy planning a 2gwh Collie Bess project in Western Australia?

State government-owned energy company Synergy has received planning approval for 2GWh Collie BESS project in Western Australia.

Collie Battery will deliver a significant economic boost to the Shire of Collie, as part of the region's energy transition, creating over 120 construction jobs and opportunities for local suppliers. The project will have an annual community benefit-sharing program, co-designed with the local community.

The first battery units have been installed at Synergy's \$1.6 billion Collie BESS (battery energy storage system), which is set to be one of the largest in Australia. The Collie BESS is scheduled to be connected to the grid in 2025, and once complete will provide 500MW of power and 2000MW/h of storage.

Perth-based Southern Cross Electrical Engineering (SCEE) has been awarded a \$50 million (USD 33.6 million) contract by state-owned energy utility Synergy, to construct switchyards works at the 500 MW / 2,000 MWh Collie battery energy storage system (BESS).. The windfall is the second allocated to SCEE, after it was awarded a \$160 million contract in ...

The flagship project of the two is a 500MW/2,000MWh BESS at Collie, a historic seat of Australia's coal industry. The handover from coal to cleaner energy sources has been coming for some time, and private entities including French independent power producer (IPP) Neoen have proposed their own BESS projects for Collie too.

Earlier in December, the company was granted planning approval for an even bigger project in the country, its proposed Collie Battery in Western Australia, which could be up to 1GW/4GWh. ... System integrator EVLO Energy Storage (EVLO) has completed delivery of the BESS units for a 12MW/64MWh California BESS project, its first in the state.

The Collie Battery is a proposed one-gigawatt / four-gigawatt hour Battery Energy Storage System. The project, being developed by Neoen, is to be located near Collie, WA, approximately 150 kilometres south of Perth, and will connect to the Western Electricity Market via the existing Shotts substation.

Collie Battery Energy Storage System (BESS). The site is approximately 86ha in area and is made up of lots 775 and 784, located on the southern side of Collie-Williams Road, just over 12kms north-east from the Collie townsite. The project intends to establish up to 1 GW battery energy storage system to provide greater reserve capacity to the South

The BESS project has been labelled a "big battery" by ZEN in a possible nod to the largest operational BESS in Australia, the 300MW/450MWh Victorian Big Battery on the other side of the country, which went online in December 2021. The largest project in development in the country is a 2GWh BESS in New South Wales, approved last month.

Although the MW power of the BESS has not been revealed, most BESS projects in California are 4-hour duration (to qualify for grid operator CAISO's Resource Adequacy framework) which would make this BESS

The BESS, planned for construction in the town of Collie, is tentatively expected to be between 600MWh and 800MWh, according to a statement issued last week from MacTiernan's office. Australia's biggest project of this kind so far is the 300MW/450MWh Victorian Big Battery on the other side of the country, which went online a few weeks ago.

The project will include the supply, installation and commissioning of 330kV transformers, circuit breakers, surge arrestors, current/voltage transformers and a control room. The 500MW/2,000MWh Collie BESS is due to be completed in late 2025, and it is set to become one of the biggest battery energy storage systems in Australia.

The WA Government announced that construction had commenced on the project, which is scheduled for completion by the end of 2025. May 2024 Synergy has awarded SCEE Electrical a \$160 million contract for the main works of the Collie BESS, including civil, electrical and major equipment installation works.

Alongside the Kwinana BESS projects, Western Australia is also home to Neoen's 500MW/2,000MWh Collie battery, which is regarded as one of the largest in Australia. Origin Energy's Eraring site is the largest BESS in Australia, and an expansion plan was recently released to bring the capacity to 2,800MWh.

The first stage of Neoen's Collie BESS (battery energy storage system) has commenced operations ahead of schedule. Since 1 October 2024, the battery has been delivering grid reliability services under contract with the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) - less than 18 months after the project began construction.

The budget committed to funding two further BESS projects following the first at Kwinana: KBESS 2, and a 500MW/2,000MWh system at Collie, the site of a coal-fired power plant. Former naval officer McGowan made a shock resignation about a month ago, citing the strain of governing through a pandemic among his reasons.
