Energy Snapshot Dominican Republic This profile provides a snapshot of the energy landscape of the Dominican Republic, a Caribbean nation that shares the island of Hispaniola with Haiti to the west. In 2014, the Dominican Republic's utility rates were approximately \$0.19 per kilowatt-hour (kWh),<sup>1</sup> below the regional average of \$0.33/kWh.

The growth of renewable energy in the Dominican Republic is supported by the legal framework which includes the General Electricity Law 125-01, Renewable Energy Incentives Law 57-07, General Law on Environment and Resources Law 64-00, and net metering legislation.
