

What type of power outlet does El Salvador use?

What is El Salvador's energy sector like?

El Salvador's energy sector is largely focused on renewables. El Salvador is the largest producer of geothermal energy in Central America. Except for hydroelectric generation, which is almost totally owned and operated by the public company CEL (Comisi3n Hidroel3ctrica del R3o Lempa), the rest of the generation capacity is in private hands.

Does El Salvador need electricity?

Demand for electricity in El Salvador has grown in conjunction with the introduction of cryptocurrency as legal tender; notably geothermal power close to volcanoes will power Bitcoin mining. El Salvador's total electrical consumption during 2019 totaled 22,833 TJ (terajoules), with the industrial sector being the largest consumer.

What is El Salvador's energy supply?

El Salvador's energy supply primarily comes from fossil fuels, such as oil, gasoline, diesel, liquid petroleum gas (LPG), kerosene, and bunker fuel. Natural gas does not play a role in El Salvador's energy supply.

Is biomass a good energy source in El Salvador?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important energy source in lower-income settings.
