

Electric boiler energy storage installation

What is a storage electric boiler?

It is typically cheaper and easier to install than other types of electric boilers because it doesn't require a tank. A storage electric boiler heats water to store in a hot water tank. With this type of boiler, you can take advantage of cheaper electricity rates at night if you have a smart meter or day/night meter.

How does an electric storage boiler work?

An electric storage boiler works in a similar way to a combi gas boiler, by heating hot water on demand, as required, without the installation of a water tank. As such, combi boilers can provide an easy installation for a source of both hot water and central heating.

How do you secure a boiler?

The boiler is secured in place, ensuring it is correctly levelled and in the appropriate location for the power supply and plumbing connections. Plumbing connections for electric boilers typically involve a simple cold input and hot output for system boilers, with additional connections for domestic hot water in combi boilers.

Do electric boilers need a hot water storage cylinder?

Electric combi boilers: These do not require hot water storage cylinders and provide hot water on demand. They are popular in flats and small to medium-sized homes where space is scarce.

How do I improve the efficiency of my electric boiler?

One way to enhance the efficiency of your electric boiler is by setting a room thermostat to the lowest comfortable temperature, typically between 18 and 21 degrees Celsius. This can save energy without compromising comfort.

How do you install a gas boiler?

The first step in the installation process is to safely disconnect and remove the existing gas or oil boiler. The removal of a gas boiler includes the safe capping off of the gas line by a certified heating engineer. When an oil boiler system is removed, the oil feed and the old oil tank must also be removed and safely disposed of.
