

Energy storage investment in 2023

Will energy storage grow in 2023?

Global energy storage's record additions in 2022 will be followed by a 27% compound annual growth rate to 2030, with annual additions reaching 110GW/372GWh, or 2.6 times expected 2022 gigawatt installations. Targets and subsidies are translating into project development and power market reforms that favor energy storage.

What's happening in the energy storage sector in 2023?

A roundup of the biggest projects, financing and offtake deals in the energy storage sector that we have reported on this year. It's been a positive year for energy storage in 2022, with new markets opening up and supply chain bottlenecks and price spikes for battery energy storage systems (BESS) easing, though challenges remain.

How much energy storage does the world have in 2023?

As of the first half of 2022, the world added 27.3 GWh of installed energy storage capacity on the utility-scale power generation side plus the C&I sector and 7.3 GWh in the residential sector, totaling 34.6 GWh, equaling 80% of the 44 GWh addition last year. Despite a global installation boom, regional markets develop at varying paces.

Will China add more energy storage capacity in 2023?

InfoLink expects China to add 39 GWh of energy storage capacity in 2023. The U.S. added 8.2 GWh of installed energy storage capacity in the first half of 2022, far behind anticipations. Constructions under the IRA face delays worse than expected.

Which countries will add more energy storage capacity in 2023?

France and Germany launched tenders successively. In 2022, Europe may add 17 GWh of installed energy storage capacity, with 9 GWh in the residential sector. Overall, China, the U.S., and Europe saw installed capacities growing at varying paces in the first half of 2022.

How much money will be allocated to storage projects in 2023?

Residential batteries are now the largest source of storage demand in the region and will remain so until 2025. Separately, over EUR1 billion (\$1.1 billion) of subsidies have been allocated to storage projects in 2022, supporting a fresh pipeline of projects in Greece, Romania, Spain, Croatia, Finland and Lithuania.
