What is an Eraring Bess?

The Eraring BESS will include: Rows of enclosures housing lithium-ion type batteries connected to associated power conversion systems (PCS) and high voltage (HV) electrical reticulation equipment. A substation housing high voltage transformers and associated infrastructure.

When will Eraring Bess come online?

Stage one of the Eraring BESS is now under construction and is anticipated to come online in the final quarter of 2025. Stage one has a capacity of 460MW and a dispatch duration of two hours.

What's going on with the Bess market in Germany?

The grid-scale BESS market in Germany has picked up in the past year, as explored in a special report in an edition of our quarterly journal PV Tech Power last year. Wind and solar projects are prominent within Tion's portfolio, however in November 2022 it acquired its first BESS project - a 8MW/9.3MWh in Bacup in the northwest of England.

Will Bess acquire 90% of Thuringia?

What does Bess stand for?

Origin is seeking regulatory and environmental planning approval for the construction and operation of a grid-scale Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) with a discharge capacity of 700 MW and storage capacity of 2,800 megawatt hours (MWh) within the Origin landholding associated with the EPS (the Project).

Where is Eraring located?

The Eraring Battery Energy Storage System is located approximately 1.3 km from the eastern boundary of the site, with the suburb of Eraring being situated 500 m east of the project area. Residential properties in Eraring are zoned as RU4 (Primary Production Small Lots). Eraring Lake, zoned as W1 (Natural Waterways), is located within the suburb.

The Eraring battery will be installed at Origin's Eraring Power Station. Origin may elect to expand the battery to 700 MW and 2,800 MWh in the future. The companies have signed an engineered equipment delivery (EEQ) contract with a total value of slightly more than 300 MEUR, Wärtsilä's largest single energy storage deal to-date.
