Thus, Futuna is subjected to periodic earthquakes, the most recent occurring in March of 1993. The topography is more pronounced than on Wallis, with hills rising to 524 m / 1,719 ft. (Mt. Puke on Futuna) and 417 m / 1,368 ft. (Mt. Kolofau on Alofi). Alofi was inhabited until around 1840, but was abandoned because of a shortage of water.
