What is the new European Union Entry-Exit System (EES)?

There's been a lot of talk recently about the new European Union Entry-Exit System, also known as EES. Many questions have come up, especially regarding travel to and from the Schengen Zone. As we know, Schengen or Tourist Visas allow for free travel within the European Union for a measured amount of time.

What is EES & ETIAS?

The EES, which is a border control system, is not to be confused with the ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorisation System), which is a travel authorization for Non-EU citizens who do not need a visa to travel to Europe.

When will the European Economic System (EES) become effective?

But its launch has been delayed for the fourth time since 2022. According to official EU sources, the EES was due to become effective on November 10 - just a month and a half after the announcement - although travellers will now have until next year to plan for the changes.

Can a non-EU/EEA passport holder travel to Spain?

Some of the more stringent requirements for entry to Spain for non-EU/EEA passport-holders - such as having to show proof of accommodation, including a 'letter of invitation' signed by a notary from friends or family they are staying with - are likely to become redundant.

Who will be affected by the EES?

People who are already citizens of the EU or the Schengen countries will not be affected and will be able to travel freely throughout the area. Instead, the EES will apply to people coming from what the EU calls a 'third country' - namely those who are not EU citizens or citizens of the Schengen area.

What is EES registration?

EES registration will replace the current system of manually stamping passports when visitors arrive in the EU. The exact date that EES will be introduced has not been confirmed. When EES is introduced, you will need to create a digital record on your first visit to the Schengen area at the port or airport on arrival.
