

What is the lithium-ion battery safety bill?

Introduced on 29 July 2024, the Lithium-Ion Battery Safety Bill is a private member's bill aimed at enhancing the safe storage, use, and disposal of lithium-ion batteries, specifically targeting householders and battery energy storage systems (BESS).

What does the new lithium-ion battery Bill mean for local authorities?

The bill also includes provisions for criminal and civil liability for non-compliance. Disposal Regulations: Regulations will be introduced to improve the safe disposal of lithium-ion batteries, which have been the cause of fires in waste systems. Notably, the bill avoids placing additional financial burden on local authorities.

What are the requirements for lithium-ion batteries storage?

ESS) are recommended?, including: Lithium-ion batteries storage rooms and buildings shall be dedicated-use, e.g., not used for any other purpose. Containers or enclosures sited externally, used for lithium-ion batteries storage, should be non-combustible and positioned at least 3m from other equipment,

Are lithium-ion batteries safe for electric energy storage systems?

IEC has recently published IEC 63056 (see Table A 13) to cover specific lithium-ion battery risks for electric energy storage systems. It includes safety requirements for lithium-ion batteries used in these systems under the assumption that the battery has been tested according to BS EN 62619.

How should lithium-ion batteries be stored?

Conditions for lithium-ion batteries The scale of use and storage of lithium-ion batteries will vary considerably from site to site. Fire safety controls and protection measures should be commensurate with the risks. Batteries are used, charged, or stored: Only use batteries purchased from a reputable manufacturer or supplier. Do not leave/store batteries in

Do lithium-ion batteries need to comply with transportation safety regulations?

Lithium-ion batteries need to comply with transportation safety regulations. These regulations are separate from electrical safety regulations and are part of the dangerous goods regulations. Compliance is required for sub-suppliers, manufacturers to distributors, and for batteries in or outside of products.

Thermal runaway events occur in almost every country in which battery storage is used. The provision of a suitable and sufficient fire risk assessment that is subject to regular review and appropriately communicated. For a fire risk assessment to be considered suitable and sufficient it must consider all significant risks of fire. Where lithium-ion batteries are concerned this should cover handling,

storage, use and charging, as appropriate.
