That said, solar tends to make financial sense if you can fit at least 8 or 10 panels on a south, west, or east-facing surface without too much shade. Those systems (possibly in combination with a battery) should be able to make enough free electricity to offset the cost of installation in well under a decade.

The mount lifts your solar panel to an optimum height and establishes an air gap between the panel and the surface. Pole-Mount Solar Power - Solar panels are attached to a metal frame, and that frame is then attached to the top of a pole mount, elevating the panels higher off the ground and allowing for additional customization. With pole-mounted solar, you can add a tracking system (either single-axis or dual-axis) that rotates throughout the day to maximize exposure to sunlight.

Their formula makes for very large exclusion zones. If a house has an average height (H) of 4m, a depth (D) of 10m, and a breadth (B) of 15m and the exclusion zone around the edge of the roof is equal to "Minimum of
