How much money can you store in an ATM?

Bills are usually stored in containers called "cassettes" and organized by dollar amount or denomination. Smaller establishments like stores, restaurants, nightclubs, and gas stations may have lower cash limits in their ATMs, anywhere from \$2,000 to \$5,000 and up to \$10,000 for some.

How much cash does a retail ATM hold?

The answer might surprise you - there's often a big difference between what these machines could hold and what they actually contain. Your average retail ATM in the US typically holds between \$10,000 and \$20,000 in cash. This makes perfect sense when you break it down: most retail ATMs use a single cash cassette that can hold about 1,000 bills.

How many bills can an ATM hold?

A typical ATM can house several thousand notes across all its cassettes, often ranging from 2,000 to 10,000 bills. This physical limitation means that even highly trafficked ATMs necessitate regular replenishment schedules. The design prioritizes efficient dispensing and secure storage within a compact footprint.

How much money can a single ATM hold?

These high-traffic locations occasionally configure their ATMs for maximum capacity: A fully-loaded machine might have four cassettes with 2,000 notes each, totaling 8,000 bills. If those were all \$100 bills (which is rare), you'd be looking at an \$800,000 potential capacity - nearly a million dollars inside a single machine!

What's inside an ATM you just used?

Curious about what's really inside that ATM you just used? The average retail ATM you'll encounter at your local convenience store typically holds between \$10,000 and \$20,000. This amount comes from the standard cassette that holds about 1,000 bills--usually \$20s.

Where is money stored in an ATM?

The money is stored inside cassettes. Each of these cassettes only features one bill denomination. Most ATMs only dispense \$20 bills, but some will give \$50. A typical ATM machine has four cassettes. There are two for \$20 bills and two for \$50. If the machine only gives \$20 bills, all four cassettes will only contain this denomination.

An ATM can typically hold \$20,000 to \$100,000. However, you'll typically find between \$5,000 and \$20,000 in cash at an ATM. The sum changes according to the machine's location, the venue ...
