

How to collect broken photovoltaic panels

Do solar panels need to be taken back?

Your solar panel installer is legally required to take back your solar panels or pay for a government-approved Distributor Take-back Scheme (DTS) to collect and recycle it properly. Contact your installer (or PV CYCLE, if your installer no longer exists) to arrange for your old panels to be removed and recycled at no cost.

How do I recycle solar panels?

This ensures that all solar panels are collected and recycled properly. So, get on the phone to your solar panel installer - they'll know what to do. It's most likely they'll take your panels to a Designated Collection Facility (check the DFC database to find one near you) before the panels go on to a recycling point.

How much does solar panel recycling cost?

Domestic solar panel recycling is completely free, all you need to do is contact your installer and they'll do the rest. If you're a business who wants to recycle your solar panels, there will likely be a charge. The cost of this will depend on the amount of solar panels you have, the type and the logistics.

Where can I recycle solar panels in the UK?

There already exist several solar panel recycling companies in the UK including H&H Pro, ILM Highland, and Recycle Solar Technologies. Furthermore, around 70% of Europe's solar manufacturers are part of the worldwide PV Cycle Network.

How do I get rid of a defunct solar panel?

Give your defunct solar panels to your solar panel installer. Under EU regulations (which still apply, even post-Brexit), your solar panel installer is legally obliged to take your defunct solar panels off you, or at least fund a Distributor Take-back Scheme (DTS).
