Can a water based fire extinguisher cool a fire?

Are battery energy storage systems safe?

Owners of energy storage need to be sure that they can deploy systems safely. Over a recent 18-month period ending in early 2020, over two dozen large-scale battery energy storage sites around the world had experienced failures that resulted in destructive fires. In total, more than 180 MWh were involved in the fires.

Can a fire suppression system stop a lithium-ion battery fire?

"There are fire suppression companies who claim their systems can suppress lithium-ion battery fires and prevent thermal runaway," said Brian Cashion, engineering manager at Firetrace International.

The most effective way to extinguish a lithium battery fire is usually with either water or dry chemical powder-based extinguishers such as Class D extinguishers. This method works best because these substances create a barrier between the fuel source (the lithium battery) and the oxygen needed to sustain the fire.

Never attempt to extinguish a Class B fire with water. Splashing water on a fire fueled by flammable liquids only splatters and spreads the flames, increasing the fire's latitude. A better way to combust and extinguish a Class B fire is by removing oxygen from the environment, thus suffocating it. Preventing fresh air from reaching the seat ...

Fire extinguishers are not meant to fight large or growing fires. Only attempt to fight a fire if the flames are shorter than you and if the flames are contained in a small space. Call your local fire department and proceed to evacuate immediately if the flames are taller than you, or if the fire is spreading and growing.

If the fire is small and you are fully trained to extinguish a fire, stand at least 3 metres away with the appropriate extinguisher in hand. Break the tamperproof seal and pull the pin. Hold the operating lever in one hand and with the other, remove the discharge hose nozzle from its storage point. Hold the discharge hose 5cm from the nozzle.

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o Charging and storage areas must be free of combustible material. o Fire-fighting equipment must be readily available. Stack battery-containing boxes uniformly to prevent tipping. Inspect batteries for damage before use and discard defective ones safely. A thermal runaway of a battery is an exothermic reaction so it can't be stopped until enough energy has been drained/consumed. Completely submerging a lithium fire in water will stop the combustion but again the runaway will continue. If you want a fire extinguisher rated for this type of fire you'll need an F500 encapsulating fire ...
