What happens if a solar PV company goes out of business?

One solution which homeowners can benefit from is selling power back to the grid. With the aid of innovative solar technology and government payment schemes, solar panels are now more sustainable than ever, as no clean energy goes to waste.

How long does it take for solar panels to pay back?

The time it takes for solar panels to be profitable (if at all) also varies by geography, as some towns simply get more sun than others. Chichester is known to be one of the sunniest locations in the UK. Here, the data shows that solar panels can pay back in just 12 years under ideal conditions (south facing, less than 20% shade, home all day).

How long does it take to pay back a solar farm?

It generally takes between five to 10 years to pay back the money you've borrowed on a solar farm through earnings from selling electricity back to the grid. How long it takes will depend on the type of solar panels you have, their size, how many of them there are, and the amount of sunlight they are exposed to.

How long does it take to recoup a photovoltaic investment?

In several regions, the average figure is 8 years. In some other regions it takes less time. Several factors should be taken into consideration when predicting how long it will take to recoup your investment with photovoltaic installations, such as: What you would have paid for electricity without solar energy.
