

# How to install an extra photovoltaic panel

How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

Can I add solar panels to my existing system?

When adding solar panels to an existing system, you can either directly integrate them by replacing some components or install them as a separate system in the same area. One option is to upgrade your current inverter and expand your solar harvest.

Can I add more solar panels?

The size of the panels you currently have installed will impact whether you can add more to your system. If your new installation means the energy your solar panel system generates stays below 3.68kW (16 amps), you will be able to continue with no issue.

What is a DIY solar panel installation?

DIY installations allow you to customise your solar panel system to match your home's energy needs and roof layout (or perhaps even a balcony). Some professional installations may offer limited options, while a DIY approach allows for optimising panel placement, choosing specific components, and tailoring the system for maximum efficiency.

What happens if I add a new solar panel system?

If your new installation means the energy your solar panel system generates stays below 3.68kW (16 amps), you will be able to continue with no issue. If adding your new solar panels generates more than 3.68kW of energy, you'll need to submit a G59 application form to the Distribution Network Officer (DNO).

Can I install extra solar panels on my roof?

It's worth remembering that installing extra panels isn't just dependent upon how much roof space you have, but how much weight the roof can support as well. Panels generally weigh between 15kg and 30kg, so older roofs, in particular, should be checked to make sure they can support your solar setup.
