How dangerous is a nitrogen leak?

What causes erratic pressure in a nitrogen accumulator?

Moisture or oil in nitrogen gas accelerates bladder degradation and causes erratic pressure behavior: Water contamination: Install desiccant filters between nitrogen source and accumulator. Oil infiltration: Inspect piston seals (piston-type) or bladder-to-popper contact (bladder-type). Replace components showing >0.5% volumetric contamination.
