Can you still get solar panels if you rent a roof?

All rent-a-roof schemes which offered free panels in return for Feed-in Tariff payments are shut to new customers, but there are still solar leases that homeowners can access. Solar subscriptions also provide an alternative way for homeowners to get rooftop panels without paying an upfront cost.

Can a rent-a-roof company install solar panels?

Where an installation is owned by a rent-a-roof company, we would expect there to be a signed 'agreement' between the relevant parties, i.e. the homeowner and the rent-a-roof company, such as a lease agreement, with the homeowner agreeing to rent their roof to the company for the purposes of installing solar PV panels.

Do you still own your roof if you get solar panels?

Most households that get solar panels still own their roof, because they buy the panels outright or use a solar subscription like Sunsave Plus, both of which allow them to maintain ownership of their roof. You can access solar roof leases which take control of your roof for a set number of years, in return for a free solar installation.

Can you get free solar panels on your roof?

Thanks to rising energy prices, more and more people are looking to invest in solar energy as a way of saving money and reducing their energy bills, making the prospect of free solar all the more tempting. Known as the "rent-a-roof" scheme, a growing number of companies are offering to fit and maintain solar panels on your roof for free.

How do rent-a-roof solar panels work?

Rent-a-roof solar panel schemes required homeowners to give a solar company the rights to their rooftop or the airspace above it for up to 25 years. That company would then install rooftop solar panels for free, in return for receiving the household's Feed-in Tariff payments.

Are there any problems with rent-a-roof solar panels?

There were several problems with rent-a-roof solar panel schemes, most of which were impossible to solve after the contract had been signed. Here are the main problems that affected rent-a-roof customers.

This is because a solar panel system usually weighs about 20kg per square metre, which the great majority of roofs can hold. However, flat roofs may not always be strong enough for solar panels. Drilling into a flat roof can cause leaks, so an installer will usually ballast the panels instead - but these will add around 80kg per panel.

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The issue with installing self-made DIY solar panels is that many of these certified engineers will refuse to certify solar panel units that they did not personally install. In order to qualify for the Smart Export Guarantee (SEG), your solar panels must be installed by a Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS) recognized installer.

The Rent-a-Roof scheme has seen a decline in popularity since the government's Feed-in Tariff (FiT) was discontinued in 2019, which subsequently led to an increase in solar panel costs. Previously, this scheme was financially advantageous for installers, allowing them to provide free solar panels to homeowners and recoup their costs through the ...

By renting out your roof area, you make your roof space available to a person or company for a limited period of time . In our case, we are talking about a roof rental for the operation of a photovoltaic system.
