What happens if you install solar panels too late?

When should you install solar panels?

When should you start stockpiling solar panels?

By installing solar panels in the spring or at the beginning of summer, you can begin stockpiling solar credits early to offset the coming winter months. The Federal Investment Tax Credit (ITC), state tax incentive, and tax rebate programs have rollover and cut-off dates, most of which occur at the end of the year.

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Each solar panel will come with a power output or power rating expressed in Watts. The majority of monocrystalline solar panels have a power rating between 300W to 550W. With the power rating you can calculate how many kWh a single solar panel will produce. The simple calculation might look like this:

From 1 February 2024, you won't pay any VAT on batteries for solar panels (previously you had to pay 20% VAT, unless you bought it as part of a solar panel system). So now you can install a standalone energy storage battery or add one to your existing solar PV system, and you'll pay 0% VAT. From 1 April 2027, this is set to increase to 20% VAT.

Now we will familiarize you with the solar inverter. The solar inverter is basically the brains of the system, it will convert direct current (DC) output of a PV solar panel into an alternating current (AC). The inverter should attach to the solar panel array and can be either indoors or outdoors.

How much do solar panels cost to install? On average, installing solar panels costs \$2 to \$4 per watt. Most systems for homes come up to \$10,000-\$25,000 after receiving tax credits.
