How much does a 3.5 kWp solar panel system cost?

A 3.5 kWp solar panel system would typically require around 10 solar panels (at 350 W each) and cost between £5,000 and £10,000. *kWp stands for 'kilowatt peak'. This is the amount of power that a solar panel or array will produce per hour in prime conditions.

How much do solar panels cost in 2023?

This shows that, so far in 2023 (up to the end of September), the typical price per kW of installed solar PV in domestic properties was £2,193. Back in 2021, the average cost was just £1,661 per kW. So, solar panel costs have risen significantly, reflecting general construction sector inflation.

How much does a solar panel system cost?

The average package 3kW or 4kW solar panel system with battery, usually comes with a 4kW to 14kW battery. The average price of a solar panel system and battery ranges from £8,500 - £14,000 but can be considerably higher depending on the battery. If you want to include a storage solution you are going to have to pay more upfront.

What costs should you consider before installing solar panels?

There are two other potential costs you should look into before installing solar panels, these are maintenance costs and repair costs.

Are solar panels a good investment?

With an average break-even point of seven years and a typical lifetime savings amount in the tens of thousands of pounds, solar panels are a no-brainer, as long as you can afford the upfront cost. What is the main disadvantage of solar panels? The main disadvantage of solar panels is the upfront cost, which is around £9,000 for a 3kW system.

Should you buy a solar PV system?

If you have the capital, the smart way to get solar is to pay for it outright. Buying your solar PV system upfront means you can recoup the cost from the start. This offers a better ROI than leaving the money in the bank. If you don't have the cash to hand, however, it's worth considering a loan.

The Smart Export Guarantee began in January 2020, after the Feed-in Tariff scheme was removed. Under the SEG, energy providers with over 150,000 customers (officially called SEG licensees) must offer a tariff that pays households and small businesses for any renewably-sourced electricity that they export to the grid.

From 1 February 2024, you won't pay any VAT on batteries for solar panels (previously you had to pay 20% VAT, unless you bought it as part of a solar panel system). So now you can install a standalone energy storage

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battery or add one to your existing solar PV system, and you'll pay 0% VAT. From 1 April 2027, this is set to increase to 20% VAT.

Example 1. Disconnection points. Note there is a gap between the panels on the blue array. It is irrelevant how large that gap is. My PV Solar Panels are connected to the PowerVault Battery using an AC-input configuration. Let's calculate this using generous efficiencies of 94% for AC-to-DC (charge) and 90% for DC-to-AC (discharge) cycles. For each 1kWh generated by the PV Panels, $1 \times 0.9 \times 0.94 = 846\text{w}$ ends up in the battery. To retrieve that back into the home I get 846×0.9 ...
