KE was established in 2005 and acquired by UEG in March 2019. KE has built a high-quality, diversified portfolio of oil and gas assets across Iraq and Egypt.

Will Chinese oil & gas company buy Kuwait Energy?

In this regard, the Chinese oil & gas exploration and production company will buy 100% of the issued share capital of Kuwait Energy through a scheme of arrangement. Founded in 2005, Kuwait Energy is said to have a diversified portfolio of oil and gas assets.

How many oil and gas assets does Kuwait Energy have?

As of 12 September 2018, Kuwait Energy's portfolio has nine oil and gas assets across the four countries, out of which it is an operator in six of them. In late April, the company and its partners officially inaugurated Siba Gas Plant in south of Iraq. Kuwait Energy is the operator of the Siba Gas Plant with a stake of 30%.

Through the acquisition of Kuwait Energy, the Hong Kong-based United Energy Group expects to transform itself into a strong medium-sized international independent oil and gas firm having a diversified portfolio of high quality assets.
