Lease rates for solar land are determined through negotiations between the landowner and the solar company. Can landowners install permanent structures on the land before a solar project?

Leasing Solar Panels Worked Example: Savings. The average house in the UK uses about 4,000 kWh of energy per year, with an annual average electricity cost of about £1969 per year. This amount combines a standing charge (pence per day) and the energy rate cost (pence per kWh).

However solar panels are still relatively expensive to buy outright, so many people opt to lease out their roof space to solar panel companies to install the panels, normally for 25 years. They may also buy a property where the roof space has been leased out in this way.
