should be securely fastened to the roof structure to ensure the stability and longevity of the solar panel installation.

The panel edges sit on the edge of the universal strut. When you have side-by-side panels, 1 x hold-down works great. For the end panels where there's only 1 edge and the square hold-down doesn't have 2 panels to hold "flat", I used a strut near the edge but completely under the panels.

Lots of lift on a panel if mounted all the way forward. If you have a solid panel, as I show with a RED outline, it will help deflect wind, but increase drag. ...
