

How much energy does Madagascar use?

Madagascar's energy balance shows that about 80% of its overall energy consumption is based on biomass (mainly firewood 68%, charcoal 10% and other biomass 2%), 17% on petrol (transport), 2% on electricity (hydropower and diesel power plants) and 1% on coal. Until today the petroleum products are all imported.

What is Madagascar's energy mix?

In 2019, Madagascar's energy mix was dominated by biofuels and wastes (85%), with oil products (11%), coal and hydro accounting for the rest of the total energy supply. In 2020, less than 5% of the population had access to clean cooking and 27% had access to electricity.

Does Madagascar have oil?

Even though Madagascar has oil in place the oilfields are not being exploited yet. The energy consumption per head is around 0,2 tons oil equivalent, which is one of the lowest in the world. Access to electricity remains low with about 20% of the total population having access to this form of modern energy.

How many people have access to electricity in Madagascar?

Access to electricity remains low with about 20% of the total population having access to this form of modern energy. In the rural areas, only about 5% have access to electricity. The installed capacity of electricity production in Madagascar accounts accordingly for some 650 MW only (production in 2008 = 486 GWh).

Does Madagascar have a potential for energy from biofuels?

There is potential for energy from biofuels using agricultural waste from the sugar sector. Jatropha is also being cultivated for its oil which is used variously in the biofuels industry. Only 1.9 per cent of Madagascar's hydroelectric power potential has currently been used (REEEP, 2012).

Does Madagascar need solar power?

Solar power is up to now only used for the electrification of some social infrastructure (including public lighting) and for single households mainly in the form of pico-solar-systems. Power Africa lists the following as Madagascar's energy sector's top issues and bottlenecks :
