

Megawatt solar power generation in Japan

How much solar power does Japan generate in 2021?

The solar PV power generation increased to 85,020 GWh of electricity in 2021, growing at a CAGR of 12.7% between 2017 and 2021. Japan is focusing on the rapid development of renewable energy. Prior to 2014, the country pegged the share of renewables at 13.5% of total generation by 2020, and 20% of total generation by 2030.

Who makes solar power in Japan?

In line with the significant rise in installations and capacity, solar power accounted for 9.9% of Japan's national electricity generation in 2022, up from 0.3% in 2010. Japanese manufacturers and exporters of photovoltaics include Kyocera, Mitsubishi Electric, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Sanyo, Sharp Solar, Solar Frontier, and Toshiba.

What is the capacity of solar power plants in Japan?

During the same year, the cumulative capacity of Solar PV power plants in Japan reached 78,650.5 MW, growing 10.1% YoY. Power generation recorded a historical growth at a CAGR of 12.7% between 2017 and 2021, while the cumulative capacity growth at 12.1% between 2017 and 2021.

How much does solar power cost in Japan?

It is found that Japan has sufficient solar PV, wind, and pumped hydro potential to support 100% renewable electricity and even 100% renewable energy. Importantly, a wide range of scenarios yield costs in the range US\$86-110/MWh, which are competitive with current spot prices.

What is the share of renewables in Japan?

The share of renewables in Japan's total annual electricity consumption averaged 22.3% in 2023, up from an annual average of 20.5% in 2022 (Figure 7). The share of solar PV was 10.7%, and together with the 1.2% share of wind power, the share of variable renewables VRE was 11.9%.

Why is solar power a national priority in Japan?

Solar power has become an important national priority since the country's shift in policies toward renewable energy after the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear disaster in 2011. Japan was the world's second largest market for solar PV growth in 2013 and 2014, adding a record 6.97 GW and 9.74 GW of nominal nameplate capacity, respectively.

In ideal conditions, a 1kW plant generates 4 units in a day. Thus, a 1000kW or 1 MW plant would generate: $4 \times 1000 = 4,000$ units in a day $4 \times 1000 \times 30 = 1,20,000$ units in a month.
