

What is Mongolia's first large-scale solar power plant project?

Mongolia's first large-scale 10 MW solar power plant project in Darkhan city. The "Darkhan 10 MW Solar Power Plant" project is jointly implemented between Solar Power International LLC and Sharp Corporation under the program of Joint Crediting Mechanism within the framework of the Low Carbon Development Partnership between Mongolia and Japan.

What is the largest solar project in Mongolia?

MCS International LLC effectively completed Zamiin-Uud Gegeen 15 MW Solar Power Plant Project, the largest solar project in Mongolia. The project is located in Zamiin-Uud Soum of Dornogobi Aimag.

Can Mongolia generate energy from renewable sources?

Mongolia offers significant potential for energy generation from renewable sources. It faces increasing energy demand that cannot be met by conventional energy sources alone. In recent years, comprehensive legislation has been implemented to create a framework for the promotion of renewable energy infrastructure investments.

What is the power sector of Mongolia?

Power sector of Mongolia is currently operated by State-owned enterprises under supervision of Ministry of Fuel and Energy. There are three main power grids: Central Energy System (CES) linking Ulaanbaatar, capital of the country, Darkhan, iron-making city; Erdenet, copper-mining city and Baganuur, coal-mining city.

Does Mongolia import power from neighboring countries?
