2.1.2. Electricity in Montserrat - Energy targets As at 2021, Montserrat relies on diesel for 96.7% of its electricity generation needs, with 3.3 % generated by the 250kW solar system installed on the rooftops of the Montobacco Building, PWD Workshop and the Brade power stations.

The solar photovoltaic (PV) project is the first phase of two planned renewable energy projects to reduce the dependence on fossil fuel for power generation on Montserrat. The rooftop solar project will provide 10% of the grid's peak daytime demand.

The current thinking is that these will be solar and geothermal energy. According to Director of Montserrat Utilities Ltd. (MUL) David Thomson the plan is to create a solar park which can provide 250KW of power to the grid. Currently, Montserrat only needs 2.2 MW in its peak seasons. Average daily usage is on average up to 1.5 MW.
