In 2015 I spent three months on the remote British island of Pitcairn in the Pacific. Pitcairn is home to just 42 people, most of whom are descendants of the Bounty Mutiny. In 2004, the island's romantic image was ripped apart by a series of child abuse trials. Now just one child remains. An enigmatic place - legendary and infamous.

Pitcairn Island is a beautiful little place, partly because of its remoteness but also because of government protection. The Pitcairn Islands Marine Reserve was established to preserve the pristine condition of the ocean surrounding the island chain. It takes in the entire exclusive economic zone surrounding the island.
