This is also a great time to make sure you did your quilt math correctly and that you have sufficient binding length to fit your quilt. If the ends of your binding strip do not overlap by at least the width of the fabric (so 2.25" binding should overlap a minimum of 2.25", 3" binding should overlap a minimum of 3", etc), add an amount that's at least double the width (2.25" ...

As far as use, I put it directly on top of my top hive box with the cover on the quilt box. IF I need to feed syrup, I place the feeder between the top hive box and quilt box. Same with the candy board. I do not use insulation on top of the quilt box due to the fact the quilt box has the air holes for air exchange and would do no good.

Most quilts come with compression straps that wrap underneath the pad and hold the edges of the quilt down. You can get quilts with either a sewn footbox or a zippered footbox with a drawstring.
