

Rwanda solar power plant setup

The energy sector of today's Rwanda has made a remarkable growth to some extent in recent years. Although Rwanda has natural energy resources (e.g., hydro, solar, and methane gas, etc.), the country currently has an installed electricity generation capacity of only 226.7 MW from its 45 power plants for a population of about 13 million in 2021.

The overall objective of this project was to develop a 10MW solar PV plant in Rwanda. OBJECTIVES. Rwanda has a total installed generation capacity of 110 MW and only 19.4% of the population have access to it. Also, 43% of the generation capacity is mostly fueled by diesel, giving Rwanda one of the highest costs of electricity in the region.

Norway-based Scatec ASA, a leading renewable energy firm in emerging markets, has completed the sale of its 54% stake in an 8.5 MW solar power plant in Rwanda. The stake, acquired by Fortis Green Fund I Rwanda Holdings Ltd and Axian Energy Green Ltd for \$ 1.38 million, was part of Scatec's strategy to streamline its portfolio and reinvest in new projects.

In July 2013, the government of Rwanda contracted with GigaWatt Global, a Dutch firm, to develop an 8.5 Megawatt solar power plant in Rwamagana District, Eastern Province, for a contract price of US\$23 million (RwF:15 billion). GigaWatt Global would finance, build, own and operate the facility for 25 years, with the power produced sold to Rwanda Energy, the national ...
