

Solar power plant subsidy policy

Do subsidies affect people's willingness to install solar panels?

Analysis of data from the past 15 years shows that subsidies do have a significant impact on people's willingness to install solar panels. Introduced when the Labour Party was last in power in 2010, the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) scheme aimed to encourage the uptake of solar by paying homeowners for the electricity they generated.

Who is eligible for benefits under solar power policy?

All Solar energy based power project Developers (Solar PV/Solar thermal) and manufacturing units of equipments, ancillaries related to Solar Power projects shall be eligible for benefits under the Policy. Only new plant and machinery shall be eligible for installation under the Policy.

Who is eligible for installation under solar power policy?

Only new plant and machinery shall be eligible for installation under the Policy. For the development of Solar power Projects under this policy, any Individual/Firm/Society/Institution/Registered Company etc. shall be eligible to apply.

What is Madhya Pradesh's solar energy policy?

Who is eligible for solar energy incentives?

Projects on Private Land: Any Developer willing to establish power generation projects based on Solar Energy (Solar PV/Solar thermal) on private land under this category in the state shall be eligible for incentives under the new Policy, subject to registration with the GoMP.
