

Solar power station project Jordan

What solar projects are being built in Jordan?

Jordan has several large-scale solar projects under construction or in the planning stages, including the 800 MW Al-Dhafra project, which is being developed by the Abu Dhabi National Energy Company (TAQA) and the 400 MW Al-Risha project, which is being developed by Saudi Arabia's ACWA Power.

How does Jordan support the development of solar energy?

In addition, Jordan has signed several agreements with international organizations and foreign governments to support the development of its solar energy sector. For example, in 2018, Jordan signed an agreement with the International Finance Corporation (IFC) to support the development of a 200 MW solar project in the country.

What is the biggest solar power plant in Jordan?

In October 2016, Jordan signed a power purchase agreement with Masdar, a clean energy developer based in Abu Dhabi, UAE to build the biggest single solar installation in the country, Baynouna Solar Power Plant, with a 200 MW capacity.

Will Jordan build a solar power plant?

The idea, first announced a year ago, is for Jordan to build 600 megawatts of solar power capacity that would be exported to Israel. In return, Israel would provide water-scarce Jordan with 200 million cubic metres (mcm) of desalinated water.

What is the solar energy potential in Jordan?

The solar energy potential in Jordan is enormous as it lies within the solar belt of the world with average solar radiation between 4 and 8 kWh/m², which implies a potential of 1400-2300 GWh per year annually.

Can Jordan build a hydroelectric power station?

Jordan does not have any notable bodies of flowing water suitable for the construction of hydroelectric power stations. The only such plant is at the King Talal dam on the Az Zarqa River, with a capacity of 5 MW.

Jordan's largest solar power plant. Bennouna Solar Power Plant Project; Situated in the east of Jordan's capital, Amman, the Bennouna plant, which became commercially operational in 2020, is Jordan's largest solar project, serving 160 thousand homes annually, and contributing to reducing CO2 emissions by 369 thousand tons per year.

Baynouna Solar Power Plant is a 200 MW photovoltaic power station in Amman, Jordan. Construction began in late 2017, and it opened in 2020. It has been operational since February, 2023.
