e in St. Kitts and Nevis in 2020. 95% of electricity is generated through diesel power plants, with approximately 3% (2.2 MW) coming from wind and approximately 2% from solar (1.5 MW) for a total of 5.6%. St. Kitts and Nevis is committed to reducing its emissions and limiting the average global temperature rise to 1.5°C.

The two islands have completely separate energy systems - the St Kitts Electricity Department is a government-owned utility company responsible for the generation, transmission and distribution of electricity on St Kitts. The Nevis Electricity Company is a public-private company that provides the same services on Nevis.
