How has energy consumption changed in Sweden?

Energy taxes and information campaigns are preferred. The total energy consumption in Sweden increased from 31.7 Mtoe in 1990 to 33.4 Mtoe in 2009. Total final energy consumption for the residential and tertiary sector has decreased since 1990 while the transport sector has increased.

How does Sweden use energy?

In Stockholm, the body heat from commuters passing through Stockholm Central Station is used to heat a nearby building, and in the southern town of Västerås, there are passive high-rises.
