

Teacher Wang Chong talks about solar power generation

Who is Wang Chong?

Wang Chong (Chinese: 王充; pinyin: Wáng Chōng; Wade-Giles: Wang Ch'ung; 27 - c. 97 AD), courtesy name Zhongren (仲任), was a Chinese astronomer, meteorologist, naturalist, philosopher, and writer active during the Eastern Han dynasty.

What did Wang Chong think about eclipses?

Although Wang Chong was certain of his ideas about eclipses (without the knowledge of how gravity forms naturally large spherical bodies in space), his ideas on this would not be later accepted in China.

What did Wang Chong believe?

An original thinker, Wang Chong rejected key elements in the theory of correspondences between Heaven and mankind, popular among the Han intellectuals and favored by the Han court. He also denied the existence of ghosts and ridiculed commoners who believed in demons and other supernatural powers.

Was Wang Chong right about the water cycle?

Although Wang Chong was right about the water cycle and other aspects of early science, his stern opposition to mainstream Confucian thought at the time made him a skeptic of all their theories, including eclipses (the Confucian-accepted model being correct).

Was Wang Chong a rationalist?
