

Does Thailand have a solar grid?

According to the International Energy Agency, the Thai grid has the capacity to take on greater amounts of variable renewable energy, such as derived wind and solar.¹⁹ In particular, solar projects, especially if co-located with energy storage, will likely be deployed significantly in the next decade.

What is Thailand doing to manage grid volatility?

Thailand is currently carrying out pilot projects for the development of an advanced grid system to better manage the grid volatility that accompanies the introduction of renewable energy. The private sector is also pursuing opportunities to develop projects with battery energy storage system (BESS) technologies.

Does Thailand need a new energy grid?

The Thailand energy grid needs modernisation and optimisation to support the increasing usage of renewables with this expected to be a point of emphasis in the upcoming Thailand National Energy Plan.

Does Thailand have a smart grid?

Smart Grid development in Thailand has been fragmented, as EGAT, PEA, and MEA mostly focus on their own projects rather than collaborating. All three agreed to jointly research a National Energy Trading Platform in 2018, but updates have been scarce.

What are the potential limitations of Thailand's energy grid?

The potential limitations of the Thailand energy grid are coming into focus as the country seeks to expedite its green transition. With more renewables slated to come online over the next few years, there is a pressing need to make faster progress on Smart Grid advancements.

What is Thailand's energy transition?

The Thai power sector's energy transition aims to be shifted to a cleaner generation system and efficient electricity consumption with a higher share of renewables and higher improvement of energy efficiency (ITA, 2022).
