How can I reduce the noise of an RV generator?

To reduce the noise of an RV generator, you can make a simple DIY noise reduction box. You can buy noise reduction panels made of foam that noticeably reduce generator vibration and sound. Build a fiberglass box that is larger than the generator to allow it space to breathe.

How can I make an RV generator sound quieter?

To make an RV generator sound quieter, ensure that the box housing the generator is larger than the generator itself, allowing enough space for air intake. After building the box, line the inside walls with noise reduction foam to contain the noise. This will help keep the generator's sound levels in check.

Why does my RV generator make weird noises?

If your RV's generator is making odd sounds like rattles, hums, grinds, or squeals, it's a sign of trouble. These weird noises point to a problem that needs quick fixing to prevent more issues. First, pinpoint what kind of noise your generator is making. Check if it changes based on how much power you use.

How to quiet a noisy RV generator?

To quiet a noisy RV generator, build a box around it and blanket the inside walls with noise reduction foam. This is an effective and one of the cheapest methods. Remember, the generator must have enough air intake for the engine to run unobstructed.

What is the cheapest way to quiet an RV generator?

The cheapest method to quiet an RV generator is to create a noise reduction box. An average old school RV generator emits close to 80 decibels while in use. Creating a noise reduction box is an effective and affordable solution. Modern, quieter generators run anywhere from 50 to 60 decibels.

One extra detail I noticed while being inside the RV, running the generator and having it shut off on its own: The generator shuts off, the light in the remote start switch on the dashboard turns off, and then a second or two later I hear a click in the 120V breaker panel as if a breaker tripped, though no breakers physically move.

I have an 07 Fleetwood Discovery 39v with the Onan Quietdiesel 7500. I also have the Onan Energy Command 30 auto generator start aka AGM. "Occasionally" I will hear the girl pump priming (clicking).
