Will Tokyo require solar panels on new detached houses?

This will make Tokyo the first place in Japan to require solar panels on new detached houses. The ordinance will come into force in April 2025. "We have gone ahead with requiring businesses (to install solar panels)," Tokyo Governor Yuriko Koike said at a news conference held after the ordinance was approved.

Should new homes in Japan have solar panels?

Tokyo's local assembly today ruled that all new houses built by large-scale homebuilders in the Japanese capital must have solar panels installed from April 2025. This is the first time a Japanese municipality has mandated solar on new homes.

Can a building install solar panels in Tokyo?

The Tokyo government understands that not all buildings can install solar panels due to structural or regulatory limits. Thus, the government is facilitating access to renewable energy at reasonable prices.

Will a Japanese municipality mandate solar on new homes?

This is the first time a Japanese municipality has mandated solar on new homes. It means that around 50 major builders will be required to supply homes that are up to 21,500 square feet (2,000 square meters) in size with renewables - and in particular, solar panels.
