Solar power uses a process called the photovoltaic effect, which turns the sun's radiation into electricity. Solar panels are made up of lots of photovoltaic cells containing silicon.

Are solar panels a 'permitted development'?

There are certain parameters that solar panel installations must adhere to in order to be considered a 'permitted development.' These parameters include: The solar panels must not protrude more than 200mm from the surface of the roof, or more than 1m above the highest part of the roof (excluding chimneys).

Can solar panels be installed on a listed building?

The solar panels must not be installed on a building that is a listed building, unless the panels are flush with the roof or integrated into the roof covering. If your solar panel installation falls within these parameters, your neighbours won't have any grounds to object.

Are solar panels easy to install?

Installing solar panels is usually relatively quick and straightforward, but it's still worth getting to know all the ins and outs of how it happens. After all, considering how much solar panels cost, it makes sense to understand the process.

Do I need planning permission for solar panels?

For more information, contact your local planning authority - your local council - for advice about planning permission for solar panels. If you are a leaseholder, you'll also need the permission of the freeholder to install solar panels. Is my home suitable for solar PV panels?

Can a neighbour object to a solar panel installation?

If your installation falls within certain parameters, your neighbours won't have any grounds to object. However, if your installation falls outside these parameters, your neighbours may have valid reasons for objection.
