Are ground-mounted solar panels a good idea?

Ground-mounted solar panels are great for properties with a large amount of land or a roof that's unsuitable for solar panels. If your property has a lot of outdoor space, it could fit a larger solar panel system on the ground than on the roof, generating more electricity.

Do I need planning permission for a ground-mounted solar system?

This means that most homeowners who want to install a ground-mounted solar panels system large enough to power their entire home will need planning permission. Homeowners in listed buildings will also need planning permission for their solar panels, regardless of the size of the ground-mounted solar system.

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

While most solar arrays are installed on rooftops, ground mounted solar panels make use of land space for optimal and high-volume generation, or in cases where a suitable roof isn't available.

Can solar panels be installed in a garden?

If a property has less than 30 square metres of land, ground-mounted solar panels can still be fitted in a garden, either to supplement the solar panels on the roof of the house, or to power sheds or garden lights. Can a solar panel system be installed on a property?

If your property has a lot of outdoor space, it could fit a larger solar panel system on the ground than on the roof, generating more electricity. Ideally a property should have at least 50 square metres of land, otherwise it's unlikely they'll be able to fit enough solar panels to meet its energy needs.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

The ground generally provides more room to install more panels than the roof does. On the other hand, panels on the ground can interfere with your home's overall aesthetic more than they would on the roof. Installation of ground panels also takes significantly more time and effort and is generally more expensive than rooftop panels.

Ground-mounted solar systems can be used to support both photovoltaic PV panels (for electricity generation) and solar thermal panels (to heat water). Both types of solar thermal panels are also supported giving homeowners the choice between flat plate and evacuated tube systems.
