

Will photovoltaic panels be hot on the roof

The type of solar panel known as a photovoltaic module converts this energy into electricity, which can then be stored in battery bays to be used at a later date. 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DC isolators, especially the DC isolators located at the roof (rooftop isolators), are a known common cause of fires in PV systems.
