Will Antigua & Barbuda use sustainable fuel for power generation?

The island of Antigua and Barbuda has taken the lead in utilising environmentally sustainable fuel for power generation, and this will be the first project of its kind in the Eastern Caribbean region where an LNG terminal will be coupled to a Wartsila power plant.

What is Wartsila's energy's EPC agreement with Antigua?

Mr Francis Hadeed, Director, APCL (on the right) and Rodney George, VP Caribbean, Wartsila Energy, signed EPC agreement for a 46 MW power plant delivery to Antigua in November 2021. Wartsila will supply and install a 46 MW dual-fuel power plant to the Caribbean Island of Antigua. The plant will operate with five Wartsila 34DF engines.

Why is Wartsila integrating a new power plant with an LNG terminal?

Jon Rodriguez, Director, Power Plants, North America, Wartsila Energy responded by saying: "The integration of this new power plant with an LNG terminal is a clear demonstration of Wartsila bringing its technological know-how and experience to assist its customers in making use of more environmentally sustainable fuels.

Who is Wartsila?

The technology group Wartsila has been awarded the contract to supply and install a 46 MW dual-fuel power plant to the Caribbean Island of Antigua. The engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) order was placed by Antigua Power Company Limited (APCL), an independent power producer.

How will Wartsila's LNG plant work?

The order was entered into Wartsila's order book in January 2022. The plant will operate primarily on regasified liquefied natural gas (LNG). The project combines a power plant and an LNG gas terminal, storage and regasification facility.

Will APCL deliver a 46 MW power plant to Antigua?

Associated infrastructure: Antigua Power power station; Background. The Antigua LNG terminal is a small import terminal designed to receive and regasify LNG for use in a 46 MW power plant equipped with dual-fuel Wartsila engines and operated by Antigua Power on the Crabbs Peninsula in Antigua.

The Eraring BESS site, owned by Australian utility Origin Energy, recently saw its stage three expansion green-lit. This makes it Australia's largest approved BESS with around 2,800MWh energy storage capacity, the same size as the existing black coal-fired power plant connected to the site's National Electricity Market (NEM).

A couple of months ago Wartsila also said it is deploying another project in the country which it believed will be a first-of-a-kind for the Southeast Asia region: a 54MW / 32MWh BESS on a "floating power barge" which will be integrated with a 100MW floating diesel power plant, helping to reduce emissions and run-time and increase efficiency of the thermal power ...

Its main energy storage software is the GEMS energy management system (EMS) platform, brought into its portfolio through the acquisition of Greensmith Energy Management Systems Inc in 2017. Wartsil; provides the platform as a standalone product as well as a way to manage its own energy storage products.

Wartsil's GEMS energy management system platform has grown alongside the energy storage sector for more than a decade. We caught up with Andrew Tang, vice president of Energy Storage and Optimisation at Wartsil; Energy to learn about the importance of software for the uptake of energy storage.

The order intake in Wartsil's energy business included 1,325MWh of energy storage for the first six months of the year, and 519MWh in Q2 between April and June: compared to last year when it booked just 23MWh of energy storage orders for the half year and 18MWh in Q2, and 460MWh for the entirety of 2020, the growth indeed appears strong ...

Once complete in 2027, the Eraring BESS will become Australia's largest operational battery, with a capacity of 700MW/2,800MWh.
